It was motioned by Ms. Simon and seconded by Mr. Ledbetter to introduce Ordinance No. <u>1827</u>. Mayor Guinn explained that this will allow Our Lady Help of Christians Catholic Church to donate a small piece of land so that the City can continue developing the Cemetery. After no other questions or comments, it was carried by unanimous yeas of voice vote of those in attendance to **INTRODUCE** Ordinance No. <u>1827</u>.
