

**REGULAR MEETING**

**MARCH 13, 2018**

The Regular Meeting of the Jennings City Council was convened on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. in the Jennings City Council Chambers, 154 N. Main Street, Jennings, Louisiana with President Stephen VanHook and a quorum present.

Jennings City Council Members present: Johnny Armentor, District B; Clifton LeJeune, District C; Anthony LeBlanc, District D; Stephen VanHook, District E

Jennings City Council Members Absent: Carolyn Simon, District A

The Prayer was led by Mr. LeJeune and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. LeBlanc.

It was moved by Mr. LeBlanc, seconded by Mr. LeJeune and carried by unanimous yeas of voice vote of those in attendance to **APPROVE** the Minutes of the February 20, 2018 Regular Meeting.

Ordinance No. 1735 – an ordinance wherein the City Council adopts & sets the levy of the General Alimony millage rate, Street millage rate and Library millage rate, not to exceed the prior year’s maximum. It was motioned by Mr. LeJeune, seconded by Mr. LeBlanc to introduce Ordinance No. 1735. A discussion ensued about how millages are set and/or increased. After no further public comment or questions, it was carried by unanimous yeas of voice vote, with the exception of Ms. Simon who was absent, to **INTRODUCE** Ordinance No. 1735

Ordinance No. 1734 – an ordinance to implement four-way stop signs at each point at the intersection of Wood Street & South Broadway Street, Jennings, Louisiana and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances therewith. It was motioned by Mr. LeBlanc, seconded by Mr. LeJeune to adopt Ordinance No. 1734. After no public comment or questions, it was carried by unanimous yeas of voice vote, with the exception of Ms. Simon who was absent, to **ADOPT** Ordinance No. 1734.

Next was to approve and confirm a beer and liquor permit to *Arie Kotter, CEO, Eyal Nuchamovitz, EVP & Manager Sieglinda Perkins – (GPM Southeast, LLC) - d/b/a E-Z Mart #4300* for retail sales – Class B – no drinking on premises – located at 519 Shankland Avenue. Mayor Henry Guinn stated that the paperwork was not in order because the manager had not come into the office to sign for the background check. It was just discovered that the manager listed was the district manager and not the local manager. The council agreed to postpone the vote and keep it on the agenda for next month.

With no further business, it was moved by Mr. LeJeune, seconded by Mr. LeBlanc and carried by unanimous yeas of voice vote of those in attendance to ADJOURN this Regular Meeting on March 13, 2018 of the Jennings City Council at 5:37 p.m.
