

REGULAR MEETING

MAY 9, 2017

The Regular Meeting of the Jennings City Council was convened on the 9th day of May, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. in the Jennings City Council Chambers, 154 N. Main Street, Jennings, Louisiana with President Stephen VanHook and a quorum present.

Jennings City Council Members present: Carolyn Simon, District A; Johnny Armentor, District B; Trey Myers, District C; Anthony LeBlanc, District D; Stephen VanHook, District E

Jennings City Council Members Absent: None

The Prayer was led by Ms. Simon and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. Armentor.

It was moved by Mr. Armentor, seconded by Mr. LeBlanc and carried by unanimous voice vote to **APPROVE** the Minutes of the April 11, 2017 Regular Meeting.

There were no resolutions and no ordinances.

Under *Other Business* was for Ms. Marion Fox to address the council to request forming a Joint Service Agreement with the Jeff Davis Parish Tourist Commission for construction of the new Tourist Center. Due to unforeseen circumstances Ms. Fox could not attend the meeting and asked to be taken off of the May agenda and to be placed on the June agenda. By unanimous voice vote the council agreed to place Ms. Fox on the June agenda.

Next was to ratify the action of the council at the May 2, 2017 agenda meeting wherein the Jennings City Council permanently removed the following matter from the agenda: Ordinance No. 1719 – an ordinance to authorize the City to rezone the property of *Daigle Real Estate Services* at 618 Scott Street from A-3 to A-4. By voice vote of 4 yeas and 1 nay from Councilman Trey Myers, the council agreed to **ratify the removal** of Ordinance No. 1719 from the agenda; thereby **Ordinance No. 1719 failed** due to lack of a motion.

With no further business, it was moved by Mr. Myers, seconded by Mr. LeBlanc and carried by unanimous voice vote to ADJOURN this Regular Meeting on May 9, 2017 of the Jennings City Council at 5:34 p.m.
